The volunteer will help organizing school and high school presentations, Erasmus+ projects and local projects mainly related accessibility and inclusion



ABOUT CONSTANTA

Constanța, historically known as Tomis, is the oldest continuously inhabited city in Romania. It was founded around 600 BC. The city is located in the Dobruja region of Romania, on the Black Sea coast. It is the capital of Constanța County and the largest city in the region.

As of the 2011 census, Constanța has a population of 283.872, making it the fifth most populous city in Romania. The Constanța metropolitan area includes 14 localities within 30 km (19 mi) of the city, and with a total population of 425.916 inhabitants, it is one of the largest metropolitan areas in Romania.

Constanta is a multiethnic and multicultural environment. The majority population is Romanian, which makes up about 83 percent of the city's population. The remaining 17 percent of Constanta residents are Tatar(2,6%), Turkish(2,3%), Greek(0,08%), Bulgarian(0,01%), Jewish(0,01%), Roma(0,78%), etc.
