ABOUT THE PROJECT:

EMYS - Engaging Marginalised Youth for Sustainability is a 2-year project which aims to trigger the **motivation** and enhance the **capacity** of young people to **take action** and **implement initiatives** on local, regional, national, and European levels. By doing so, young people will become **change makers** equipped to advocate and deal with the challenges they face in their communities but also on a European level.



- The easiest way to get from both airports to Nicosia is with <u>Kapnos Airport Shuttle</u>
- Make sure to check the timetable a few days before in case there have been changes
- It's advised to book your tickets in advance
