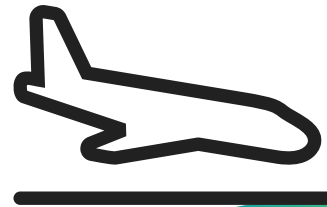
## OBJECTIVES:

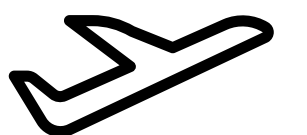

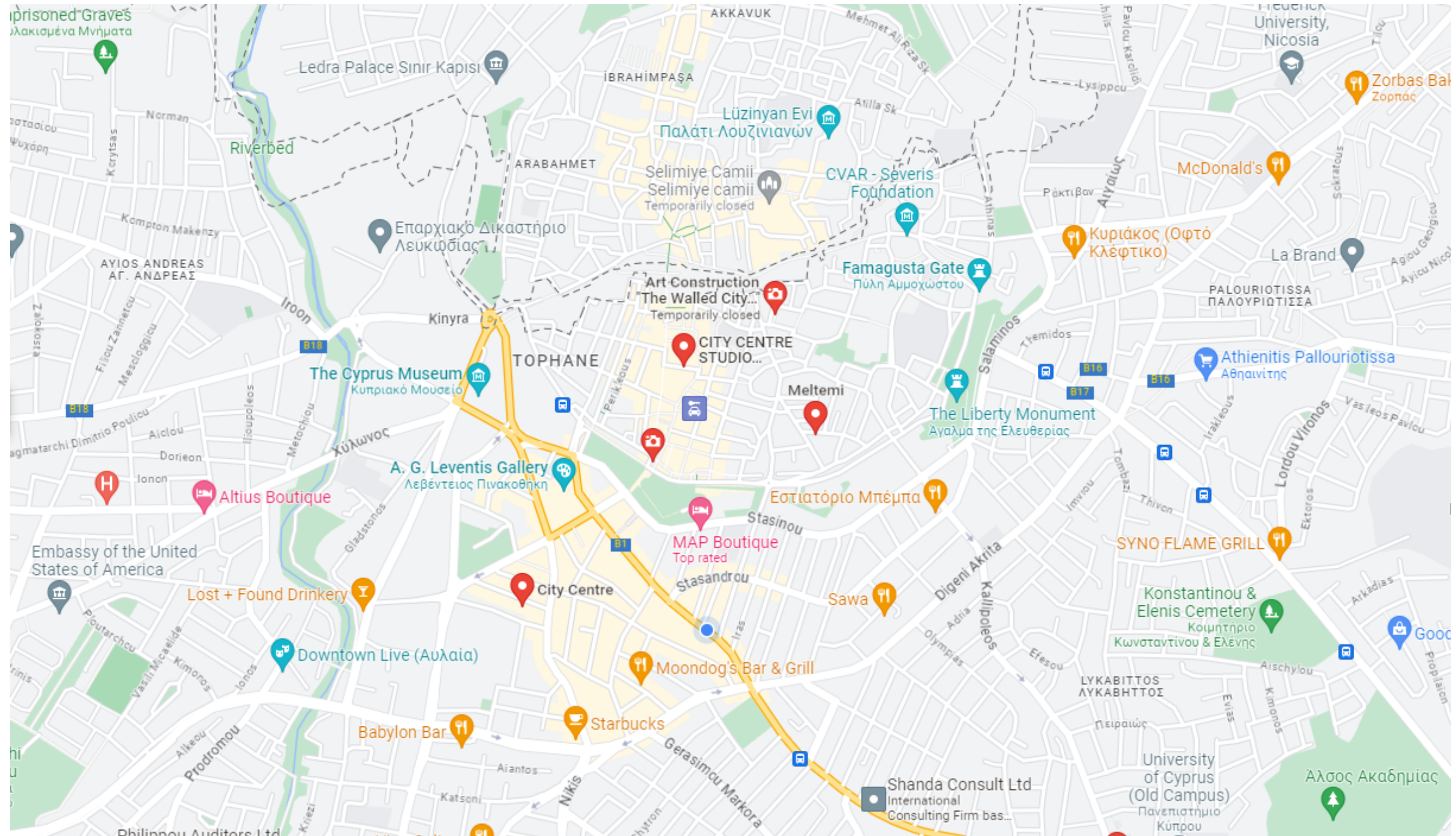

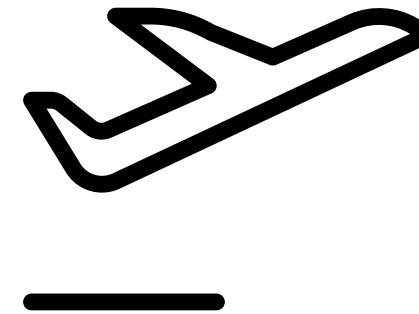

- The easiest way to get from both airports to Nicosia is with Kapnos Airport Shuttle
- Make sure to check the timetable a few days before in case there have been changes
- It's advised to book your tickets in advance

All participants traveling to Cyprus need to have a European Health card or other equivalent insurance that can cover any unexpected emergencies.

**DO NOT FLY TO ERCAN AIRPORT!!**
